

Course of Study

Bachelor of Music – Voice

(Students entering fall 2007)

This assembled information is intended to clarify the course requirements and sequence for completion of this degree. Some flexibility in scheduling is possible. Please consult the back of the CMU Bulletin for course descriptions and semester offerings. You should make every effort to comply with the attached schedule. However, we cannot guarantee that this course of study will prevent scheduling conflicts. **The course map is advisory and subject to change. The CMU Bulletin is the authoritative source of information.**

Some important considerations in following this degree program are:

- You must be fully admitted to the Music Program to begin this degree program. Please contact the School of Music Office or your private instructor if you are unsure about your status vis-à-vis the Music Program.
- In order to complete requirements on this degree you will need to be accepted for Music Candidacy at the appropriate time. Admission to Music Candidacy will be granted upon successful completion of the 300-level performance jury, a signed major and the coursework marked within with an “*”. Applications for Music Candidacy are available in the School of Music Office.
- In order to graduate with this or any other CMU degree, you must successfully complete the University Program and Competency requirements detailed in the CMU Bulletin. If you have questions about these requirements, you should refer your questions to the advisors in the Undergraduate Academic Services (#3504). In completing your UP and Competency requirements, please keep in mind that you will need 40 hours of coursework numbered 300 or above in order to graduate.
- Music majors and minors on all degree programs must receive a grade of “C” or better in each required MUS course.
